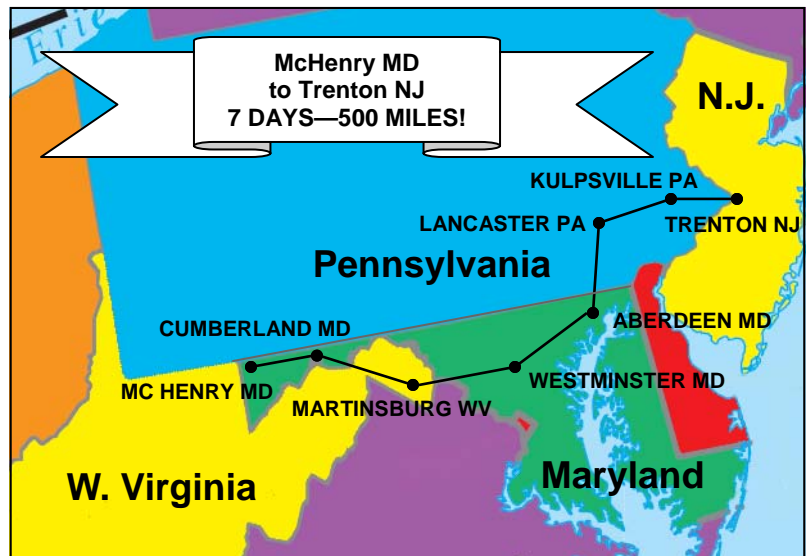

On July 9th, 2005 two hundred cyclists and support crew members from our area will depart on a grueling, one-week, 500 mile marathon ride from McHenry, Maryland to Trenton, New Jersey. During this year's ride we will ride through the beautiful hills of Maryland, West Virginia and Pennsylvania and on into New Jersey. The goal is to raise the money needed to keep the doors of Anchor House and its many programs open and provide services to thousands of kids and their families.



Anchor House, Inc. is a multi-service agency for runaway, homeless, abused, and at-risk youth and their families. For the past 27 years, Anchor House has committed its efforts to providing comprehensive, life-saving assistance to our most vulnerable population. The variety of services include:

- Angel's Wings, which provides around-the-clock care to children (birth through twelve years old) who have been abused or neglected.
- An emergency shelter, (Anchor House) for youth ages 10-17
- A transitional living program, (The Anchorage) for young adults ages 16-21
- A street-based counseling program, (Anchor Link) for youth
- School based counseling
- A variety of teen and parent support groups and violence prevention programs
- Runaway counseling program at the Trenton Police Department
- Community education and awareness presentations
